Nick Grube, *City Administrator*- Discussed the Splash Pad. Stated that he did research on the estimated cost, and doesn't feel that we should do at this time. Stated there are a few things that need to be done in the park. Discussed there needs to be a new roof on Legion Hall, the City has a new swing set to put up, playground equipment needs to be repainted, the veterans memorial needs to have some repairs, and there is needed repair to some light poles. Discussed trying to go for a grant on the next cycle.

Iim Helton, Police Chief - No updates or discussion.

Shelley Smythe, *City Clerk*- Discussed Emily Hollandsworth calling to ask about having a non-profit fundraiser on March 15, 2024 at the Gerald Lions Hall. Hollandsworth would need a temporary liquor license. The Board of Alderman stated she needs to file the application with all the required documents to proceed.

INTRO TO ORDINANCES

Bill No. 2023-10, Resolution No. 2023-03: A Resolution Authorizing the filing of an application with the Missouri Department of Natural Resources, Division of State Parks, for a Land and water conservation fund grant, authorizing a designated representative for executing required documents in behalf of the city, affirming the city's local match committing to complete the project and compliance with the LWCF program rules and regulations and laws that govern.

After brief discussion the Board decided to table the ordinance until further notice but will revisit when it is necessary.

Alderman Parker motioned to proceed to table Bill No. 2023-10, Resolution No. 2023-03 until further notice. Alderman Guerrant seconded the motion. Motion tabled.

Ward II Alderman Parker- Discussed Planning and Zoning. Stated the primary objective of the Planning and Zoning is to do street plans. Alderman Parker asked planning and zoning to take on the project of the City Plan. Discussed any plan to be a living document and should be at least a two-year plan. He feels this would be very beneficial and that the Board of Alderman be involved. Stated he would like to see this be a primary goal of Planning and Zoning. Alderman Parker also talked about growth for the city. Discussed sustainability of the City in both business and residential aspects.

Ward II Alderman Novotney- No updates or discussion


Ward I Alderman Via- No updates or discussion

Brad Landwehr- Discussed the railroad property off Main Street. Stated that the Gerald Development Association would like to have the city purchase it and would be willing to sell it to the City for \$10,000. Stated there were 2 properties, and there are issues. Discussed one issue being the building of Simply Sweet Too. Stated the GDA just wants to keep the grassy area.

Mayor Koepke asked for the GDA to make a proposal and send it to the City so we can have the attorney review. Stated the City needs something in writing. Stated that, for the time being, this should be tabled on what the city will do, and will schedule a workshop once the proposal is sent and the attorney reviews.
